The CCDTC building is located in Miami Township on Route 50 just east of I-275. The address is 6058 Kells Lane, Milford, OH 45150.

Take the Route 50/Hillsboro exit off of I-275. Turn towards Route 50/Hillsboro (not towards Milford Parkway) and turn right (east) onto Route 50. Travel approximately 2.5 miles through three traffic lights. After the third traffic light turn left onto the second street - **Kells Lane**. CCDTC's building is the second building on the right. The property adjoins Cincinnati Riding for the Handicapped.

Move Up Regulations

If a dog earns an agility title before this event, it can be advanced to the next level of competition. However, written notice MUST be given to Trial Secretary no later than 6 PM on Mon 5/03/2010. Move-ups will be accommodated on Saturday for Sunday at the trial. No verbal changes will be accepted.

Refunds

No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other causes beyond the control of the organizing committee. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. Bitches in season will be awarded a refund (with a Veterinary Certificate), less \$10 processing fee per day.

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club, or have AKC Limited Registration, or are of a registerable breed that have obtained an AKC ILP number. Dogs eligible for entry in the Miscellaneous Class at dog shows are eligible to participate. Mixed breed dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program are eligible to participate. Bitches in season, aggressive dogs, dogs that are blind or deaf or suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect its physical or mental performance, are not eligible to participate

AGILITY JUMP HEIGHT CARDS

All dogs that do not have a card (except those jumping 24" or 26") will be required to be measured by the Judge of Record. The Judge's measurement will be valid for this trial only.

OBSTACLES

Obstacles are as listed in the current edition of "Regulations For Agility Trials" from the American Kennel Club. **There will be no obstacle familiarization for the Novice classes.**

Show Site Information

CCKC is holding this Trial at the facilities of Clermont County Dog Training Club.

ALL Dogs MUST be on leash at all times when not in the ring or warm-up area. This includes outside the building! We are next to a handicapped riding facility and this is vital to the safety of the riders. It is required in the lease of the building. NO EXCEPTIONS!

All dogs MUST be kept on the Clermont County Dog Training Club property during show hours. Dogs may be exercised on show site only. Keep our neighbors happy. Please clean up after your dog. Plastic bags are provided at the trial site for dog waste pickup. **Waste containers are available in designated potty areas behind the building!**

Please respect these areas as the CCDTC would like to remain on friendly terms with their neighbors and the Clermont County Kennel Club would like to use this facility in the future!

Exercise your dog in the designated potty area only; please clean up after your dog. DO NOT let your dog potty in the landscaped areas around the building!

Due to the building size, there will be NO Indoor crating. There will be tents provided outside for crating space.

Parking is available on the front, right side and rear of the building on the Concrete/Blacktop and on the gravel areas across from the building on Kells Lane.

No smoking is allowed in the building (the Ohio smoking ban in public areas is now in effect).

Food will be available in the building at the Lucky Dog Café during the trial. Donations appreciated.

The Clermont County Dog Training Club's store will be open during the trial for exhibitors. An assortment of pet treats, supplies, and training aids will be available for purchase.

There is no overnight parking for campers and motor homes at show site.

"Exhibitors should follow their vet's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations."

Notice to Exhibitors

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely. Puppies under the age of 6 months and unentered dogs are strictly prohibited from the premises.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Note that the use of a PO Box by the Secretary means that only USPS delivery is available. And you must allow delivery without recipient's signature.

Errors on entry forms. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms. Whoever shall make such errors, no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Please TYPE or PRINT CAREFULLY the information on the entry form to minimize errors.

Entries will be acknowledged after entries close with identification numbers and a Judging Program. Should such acknowledgement not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, please notify the Trial Secretary.

Faxed, telegraphed, telephoned, e-mailed, unsigned entries, or entries not on an official AKC Agility entry form (or photocopy) with Agreement and Instructions attached cannot be accepted.

Entry fee will not be refunded in the event that the dog is absent, disqualified excused, or barred from competition by action of the trial committee. For bitches in season or disabled dogs on the day of the trial, the entry fee, less \$6.50 per day, will be refunded if a written note is presented prior to the first run of the day.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

It is expressly understood that the exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and /or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any entry fees will be made.

ALL Dogs MUST be on leash at all times when not in the ring or warm-up area. This includes outside the building! We are next to a handicapped riding facility and this is vital to the safety of the riders. It is required in the lease of the building. NO EXCEPTIONS!

Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$25.00 service charge for returned checks.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Mixed breed classes may only be offered at standalone all-breed AKC agility trials. A standalone agility event is defined as an agility trial that is not held on the same date and show site as an AKC All-Breed Dog Show or Independent Specialty for conformation.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 816-3776. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship is the Junior Handler to the Owner? _____
